Commissioners,

Once again in 2016, East Kentucky Cal Ripken will be recognizing those participants in our leagues that also show excellence in the classroom by awarding an All-State Academic Award.

In order to qualify for the highest award, an athlete that competes in our Cal Ripken division from January 1st through May 25, must complete the following:

- ⤴ The student athlete must receive no more than two B grades on their report card.
- ⤴ The student athlete must place in the 90th percentile or higher in math or reading on standardized tests or state testing.
- ⤴ The student must have attempted to achieve some type of competitive academic excellence. This could be in the form of a science fair, academic competition, young achievers, orchestra competition, etc.
- ⤴ The student athlete must have a recommendation letter by one of his/her teachers or school counselor.

An athlete that completes all of these requirements will be recognized as a member of the East Kentucky Cal Ripken All-State Academic Team.

In order to validate the selection of these athletes, the applicants must provide the signature from the teacher from their school. The documentation must be received by May 25, 2016 before 12 noon, to allow time to verify the application information.
